## Abstract Submission

Abstract submission for the FINANDEBT Conference 2014 is now open. Please send your submission to [finandebt@gmail.com](mailto:finandebt@gmail.com) no later than **20 January 2014**.

Your abstract should be between 150 and 300 words. All abstracts should be submitted in MS Word or PDF format and in French or English (including the title, author(s)' names, affiliation, and contact information). Abstracts should include **Objectives, Data and Methods, Results, and Conclusions**. JEL classification and up to 5 keywords should be used. Previously published papers may not be submitted.

If you would like to propose an organized session, please contact us by e-mail ([finandebt@gmail.com](mailto:finandebt@gmail.com)) including subject and format along with minimum 3 presenters interested in attending the session.

If your paper is accepted for presentation at the conference, you are expected to serve as a discussant or session chair in one of the sessions or presentations.

## Publication opportunities

Conference participants have an opportunity to submit their papers to special issues of the following journals:

Conference participants may like their paper considered for publication in one or more journals. A committee will be formed to decide on all the submissions. The selection process will involve two steps. In the first step, those papers that are not a good fit for the special issue journals' aims and scope will be rejected and, for these papers, complete referee reports will not be provided. In the second step, papers with potential contributions to the special issues will be sent to the referees and a final decision will be made by the conference committee who will include the editors of the special issue journals and their guest editors.
